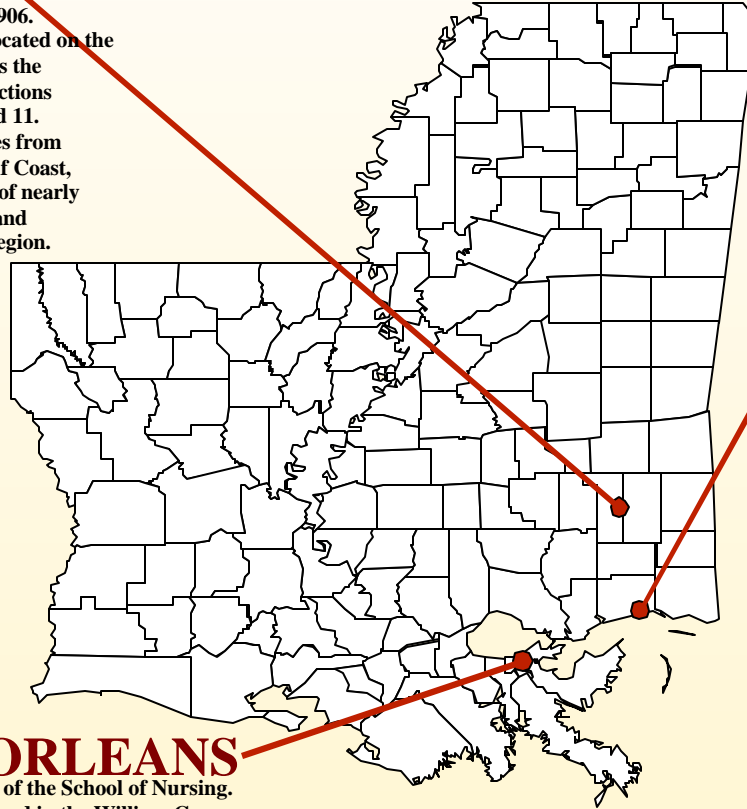
## **MISSION STATEMENT**

# WILLIAM CAREY UNIVERSITY LOCATIONS

## HATTIESBURG

is the home of the main campus, founded in 1906. On 120 acres, the university is conveniently located on the south side of the city. Hattiesburg is known as the "Hub City" because it is located at the intersections to Interstate 59 and U.S. Highways 49, 98, and 11. The city is centrally located less than 100 miles from the state capital of Jackson, as well as the Gulf Coast, New Orleans, and Mobile. With a population of nearly 50,000, Hattiesburg is the educational, retail and medical center for the southeast Mississippi region.



## TRADITION

William Carey University on the Coast was relocated to the Tradition Development on Highway 67 in Harrison County during the summer of 2009. The new campus, know as William Carey University--Tradition Campus, is accessible from Highway 49 by taking the Hwy 67 South exit and from Interstate 10 by taking either the Woolmarket exit north or the Lorraine Cowan Road exit north. The campus has two state-of-the-art buildings housing administrative and academic offices and classrooms equipped with the latest technology. The new campus opened for classes in the fall of 2009 with room for expansion as enrollment warrants.

## NEW ORLEANS

is one of the sites of the School of Nursing. The school is housed in the William Carey Building on the campus of the New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary. "America's most unusual city," historic New Orleans offers the student a rich mosaic of culture and tradition.
