Undergraduate Meeting

Attendance: 125 faculty members present

Dr. Breland opened the meeting with scripture reading and prayer. Matthew 7: 1-5

""Do not judge so that you will not be judged. For in the way you judge, you will be judged; and by your standard of measure, it will be measured to you. Why do you look at the speck that is in your brother's eye, but do not notice the log that is in your own eye? Or how can you say to your brother, 'Let me take the speck out of your eye,' and behold, the log is in your own eye? You hypocrite, first take the log out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to take the speck out of your brother's eye."

Dr. Breland reminded everyone to not be judgmental against each other, to treat others the way we want to be treated. This includes: being suspicious about others' motives, about students, programs, integrity with students (plagiarism), etc. Apply this scripture to our teaching. He would like the faculty to set the best example for our students.

Dr. King made a point, sometimes we mistake teaching with testing. Testing is not teaching, "you can't fatten a pig by weighing it." He believes students do better and learn more by being in a supporting, encouraging, and nurturing environment.

- He thanked everyone for their achievements, the list is very long.
- The amount of Baptist contributions for the July report was down. Mississippi Baptists have contributed 60 million over the years, and there have been donations from other denominations, also.
- WCUCOM School is going well. Second group of students have started school.
- Higher Education Specialist degree going well. Already started process of approval to transition that degree into a doctoral degree, which will be the second doctoral degree at WCU.
- Nursing Faculty hope to have a doctoral degree.
- A PSYD degree is a possibility for the future.
- It is a good time to be at WCU. Thank you for your commitment and support to the students.

Dr. Breland presented minutes from the last faculty meeting and they were approved by common consent.

Department Chairs, please help Adjunct Faculty get rosters in on time.

Make record of attendance every time class meets.

Must have written record you can stand behind to confirm whether a student was or was not in the class session each week.

Hybrid classes must have records that your students have participated in some way each week; if student silent for a week, record absence.

Standard needs to be that there is an attendance record for every class.
