FRESHMAN STUDENT

- Online application for undergraduate admission (available at wmcarey.edu)
- \$40 non-refundable application fee
- Official ACT (minimum score 20) or SAT (minimum score 950 combined critical reading and math) scores
- Official high school transcript that includes graduation date, class, and grade point average* OR notarized high school transcript for homeschooled students OR official GED transcript
- Proof of measles, mumps, and rubella (MMR) immunizations**
- Official and final college transcripts (if college courses are taken during high school)

TRANSFER STUDENT

- Online application for undergraduate admission (available at wmcarey.edu)
- \$40 non-refundable application fee
- Official and final transcripts from each college attended *
- Proof of measles, mumps, and rubella (MMR) immunizations**

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT

- Completed and signed application for undergraduate international admission
- \$40 non-refundable application fee
- Official ACT (minimum score 20) or SAT (minimum score 950 combined critical reading and math) scores
- Official TOEFL (minimum score 70) or IELTS (minimum score 5.5) scores
- Official and final transcripts from each institution previously attended, with official English translations included*
- Official WES (World Education Services—wes.org) evaluation for work completed at foreign universities
- Completed and signed certification of finances showing official proof of financial support with supporting bank letter verifying funding
- Proof of measles, mumps, and rubella (MMR) immunizations **
- \$500 advance tuition payment

GRADUATE STUDENT

- Completed and signed application for graduate admission
- \$30 non-refundable application fee
- Official and final transcripts from each college attended*
- Two completed recommendations
- Additional requirements related to academic program (i.e. official GRE, MAT, GMAT, MCAT or PRAXIS scores; teacher's certificate; nursing license; resume)***

FINANCIAL AID

- Apply for admission to Carey
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at fafsa.ed.gov using Carey's school code: 002447
- Apply for state financial aid (Mississippi residents ONLY) at riseupms.com
- Apply for scholarships; complete Carey's scholarship application on the following page and return to the WCU Office of Financial Aid****
- Use Carey's net price calculator to determine your estimated expenses at wmcarey.edu/tuition-and-aid
- Accept your scholarship by returning signed scholarship offer to the WCU Office of Financial Aid
- Verify your financial aid package with the WCU Office of Financial Aid

FOLLOW UP

- Visit campus and meet with your admissions counselor
- Apply for campus housing (students who are under 21 years of age and home residence is 50 miles or greater from WCU)
- Once accepted for admission, schedule an appointment with your academic advisor
- Register for classes
